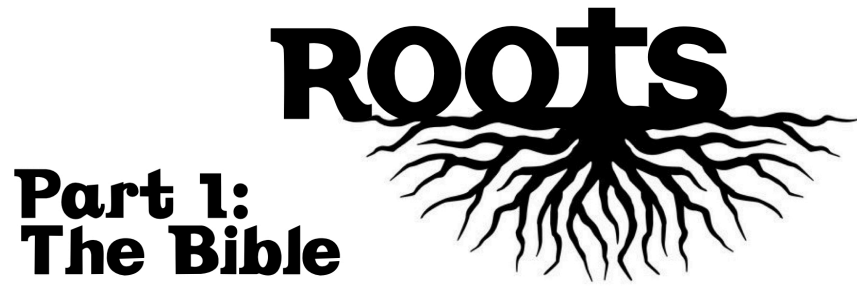

Homework (Week 4: Application and Exploration)

1) Pray and read the chapter again along with your notes. Determine how you are to apply what you have read in your life. Then find a way to hold yourself accountable to that application.

2) Pray and read the chapter again along with your notes. Then go to the professionals to compare and contrast what you've found.

Homework (Week 3: Exploration)

1) Pray and read the chapter again along with your notes. Look up definitions to words you don't know, or maybe some words you do know that might flesh out what you're reading. Simultaneously, look up verses you are curious about in other translations.

2) Pray and read the chapter again along with your notes. Search for cross reference scriptures to each verse. As you cross reference, make sure to search for patterns both within the book and within the Bible.

Homework (Week 2: Comprehension)

1A) Pray and then slowly read through the Jude.

1B) While reading, write down every thought, idea, inspiration, and question you have for each verse.

Homework (Week 1: Orientation)

1) In a readable translation, pray and then read Jude all the way through.

2) In your notes, answer basic context questions:

- Who wrote the book (and what else do we know about them)?
- Who was it written to (and where are they)?
- When was it written?
- In what style was it written?
- What is the main point of the book? (In one or two sentences.)
